Position Summary

The Georgia O'Keeffe Museum is in search of a Temporary/Seasonal Garden Project Supervisor to plan, implement, and oversee all aspects of the summer garden project to plant, maintain and harvest the historic garden; train and supervise interns and volunteers; identify and acquire resources needed to support a high-quality educational experience.

Reporting to our Historic Properties Projects Director, the Garden Project Supervisor will work as part of a team to supervise, train and engage with up to six youth interns and a Garden Project Assistant.

Responsibilities include but not limited to

- Working collaboratively with staff and partners to design a learning plan for the garden project interns, and identifying the resources needed to operationalize the learning plan
- Working collaboratively with staff, and interns to design the garden, acquire resources, and complete preparation necessary for planting
- Provide training for garden interns in garden design, planting, maintenance, and harvesting, and other special topics including upkeep of a blog and guest speakers
- Provide training for garden interns on working safely with garden tools, working in varying weather and other environmental elements, and working safely in a light physical and manual labor job.
- Provide hands-on supervision and support for interns and volunteers in all aspects of garden planting, maintenance and harvesting, including acquisition of necessary supplies and equipment
- Provide direction and support for all activities related to harvesting the garden produce
- Plan and oversee special events, including field trips, food bank distributions, and season event for family and staff
- Working with community schools to recruit interns for the program

Special Projects or Additional Duties

• Complete special projects or additional duties as assigned, and consistent with the skills, training, level of responsibility and other requirements for this position

- 2 + Years' experience working with high school students/volunteers
- 2 + Years' experience with gardening techniques, garden layout design and plant selection and harvesting
- Experience teaching; strong oral and written communication skills
