

Call for Teaching Artist Proposals

Georgia O'Keeffe Museum in Santa Fe, NM

The Georgia O'Keeffe Museum's Learning & Engagement Department seeks to connect with Teaching Artists based in Santa Fe or the surrounding region who are interested in offering **in-person** classes or workshops in collaboration with the Museum.

Proposals for in-person workshops or classes that support the L&E Department's three programming areas (Adult Programs, Community Engagement/Art 2 G.O., and Youth & Family Programs) are being collected **on an ongoing basis**. To submit a proposal for consideration, please review the following requirements and instructions.

Proposal Format

Workshop proposals must be one page and should include the following information:

- Proposed Title or Topic
- Brief Description
- Proposed Program Length
- Material/Supply Requirements
- Facility Requirements
- Which of the Museum's program areas would be the best fit for the class/workshop (Adult Programs, Community Engagement/Art 2 G.O., or Youth & Family Programs)

Proposals can be for any medium, but should also connect with Georgia O'Keeffe's artistic vision, philosophies, and/or themes that relate to the history of New Mexico and the New Mexican landscape.

Background and Qualifications

- 2-3 Years' experience teaching studio art making techniques Required
- 2-3 Years' experience as a professional artist Required
- 2-3 Years' experience designing, teaching, and facilitating art classes for adults Preferred
- 1-2 Years' experience facilitating art classes for youth (any grade level) Required if seeking to work within Youth & Family Programs

Skills and Abilities

- Experience teaching adults; strong oral and written communication skills
- Flexibility and adaptability
- Arts-based creativity
- Studio art experience
- Strong interpersonal and problem-solving skills
- Ability to connect with adult audiences
