### Lesson Objectives

- Students will be able to identify works of art in the Georgia O'Keeffe Museum setting, and current exhibition *Tewa Nangeh/Tewa Country*.

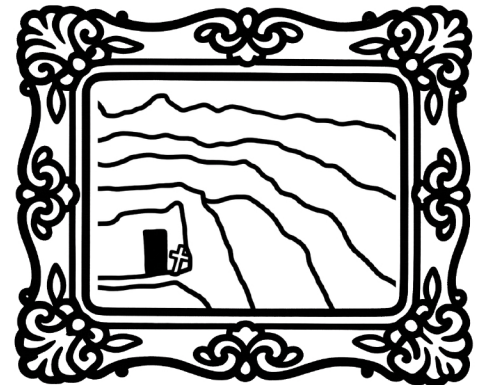

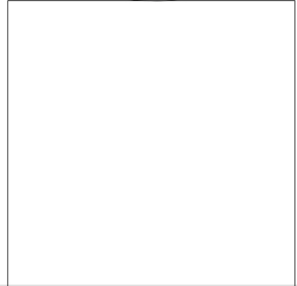

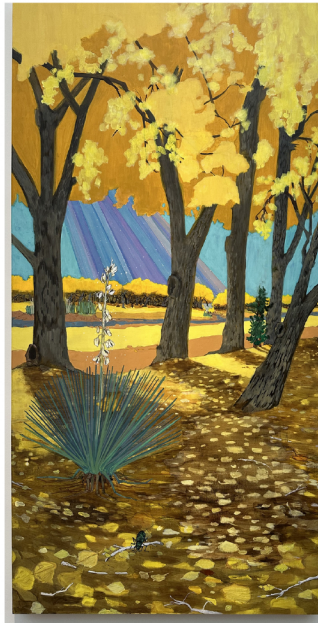

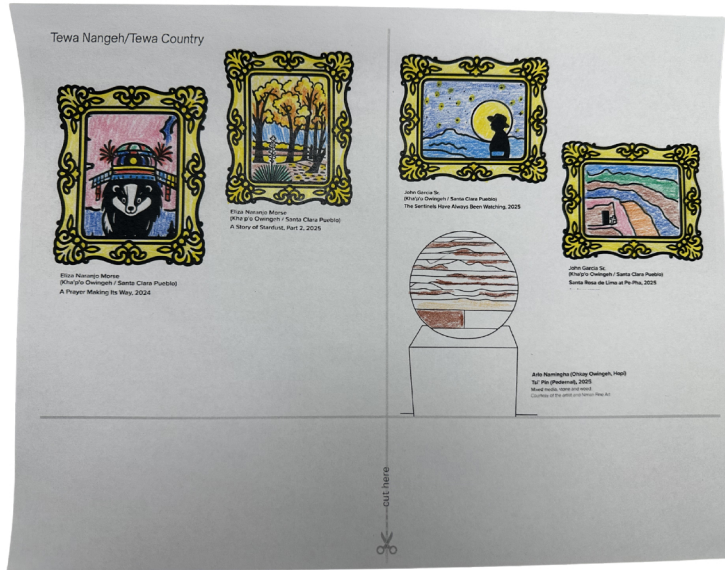

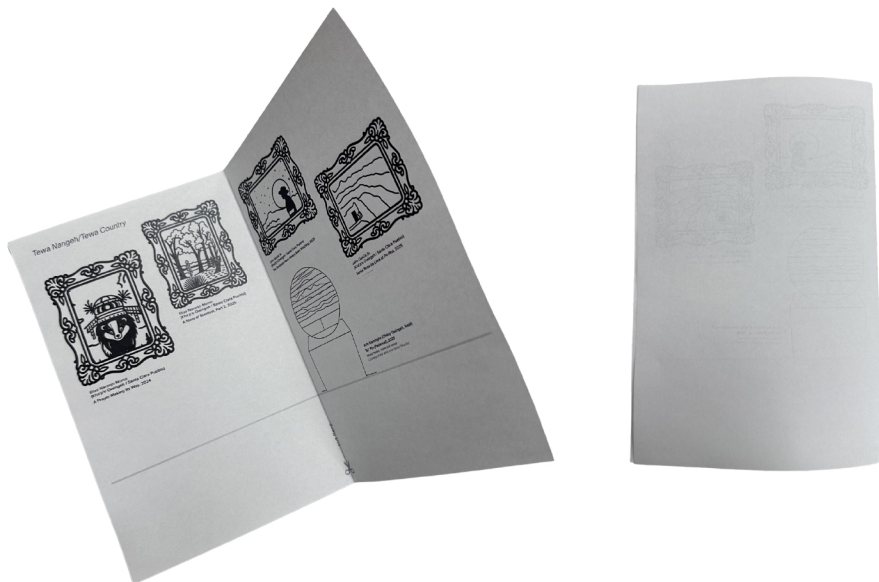


# 3D Mini Museum Art Activity Steps:

## Step 1: Color all the frames and artworks.

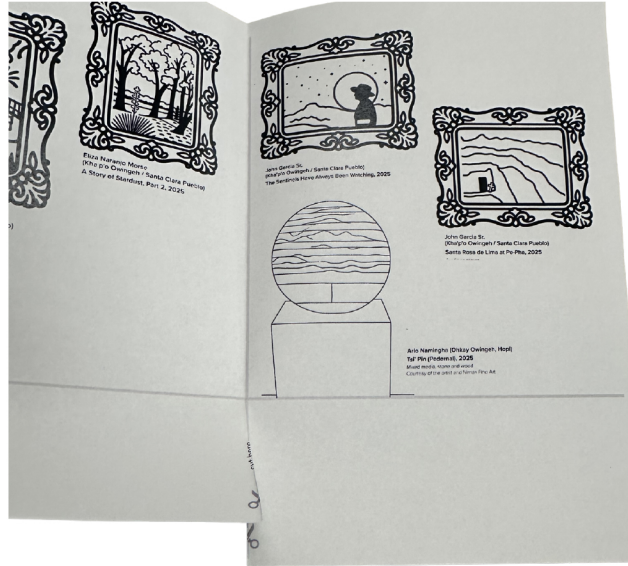


## Step 2: Fold the page in half (at the grey vertical line).

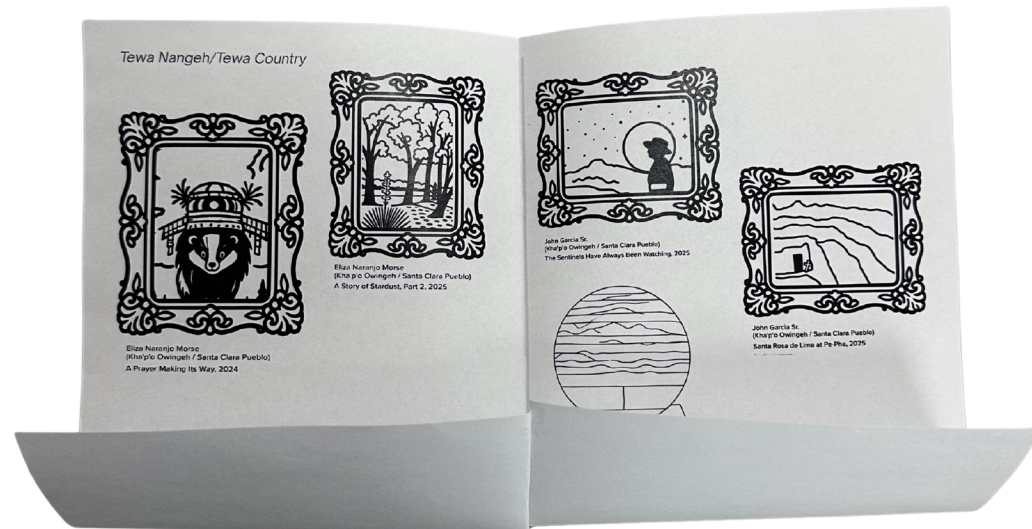


# 3D Mini Museum Art Activity Steps (Cont'd):

## Step 3: Cut the short line on the center bottom area.



## Step 4: Fold the two bottom portions of the page



## 3D Mini Museum Art Activity Steps (Cont'd):

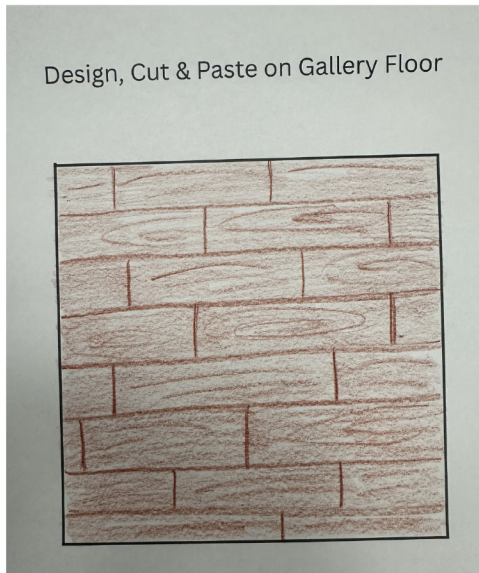
**Step 5: Slightly fold the paper in half again and glue at the bottom where the corners meet in the center. Connect the corners together, and you will be able to see the Museum pop-up.**





# 3D Mini Museum Art Activity Steps (Cont'd):

## Step 6: Design, Color and Cut the Flooring



**Step 7: Add glue to the back of the flooring page and apply to the bottom of the Museum.**
